Welcome to our first edition of "Jod Mai Khao" for the 2022 - 2023 academic school year!

The year started with our Community Picnic which was such a wonderful time for us all to come together, and enjoy having fun. Seeing our alumni, families, students and staff members together, in person celebrating the start of a school year, filled my heart and reminded me of what is wonderful about being a part of a school.

Whilst school was closed for the summer much work on our facilities occurred and we now have many new and enhanced learning areas for our students. 


